Bones are used only as levers to release hard-to-access deep layer muscles to increase therapeutic efficiency. .

The following are examples of some of the bone encoding you will learn:

Spinal vertebrae (includes coccyx & sacrum) – genetic history, ancestral lineage. Pelvis (ilium, ischium & pubis) – power, drive and achievement in your life.

L5 – relation to place L4 – attitudes towards others.

L3 – attitude, feeling toward children & parenting.

L2 – vocation & abilities.

L1 – family genetic hopes/dreams.
