Bones are used only as levers to release hard-to-access deep layer muscles to increase therapeutic efficiency and provide patients with long-term pain relief. Massage therapists can now safely address all soft tissues, including ligaments, discs, fascia, joint capsules and nerve dura responsible for much of the pain believed to be solely from muscles.

  - L4 – attitudes towards others
  - L3 – attitude, feeling toward children & parenting.
  - L2 – vocation & abilities.
  - L1 – family genetic hopes/dreams.
